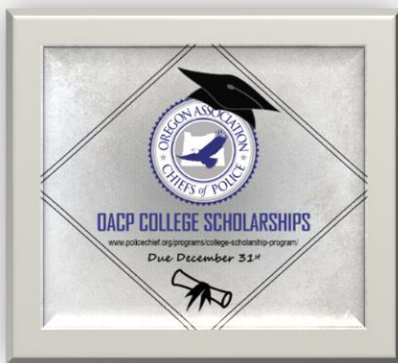

Auction Rules and General Information

The Oregon Association Chiefs of Police and the auction committee warrant neither the quality nor the value of items at the auction. All items are sold “as is” and are subject to conditions and terms stipulated by the donor. The dollar values are estimates and are not guaranteed by the auction committee for tax purposes. No exchanges, substitutions or refunds will be honored by the auction committee. Bidders must be 21 years of age to purchase any item containing alcohol or firearms.

This auction will take place on the OACP Facebook page or related page. At 1000 hours on Saturday, December 5, the first photo and description of an auction item will be posted. Additional items will be posted approximately every 5 minutes after that. To bid, you will simply comment on the photo of the item(s) along with the dollar amount. Bidding will close at 1500 hours on Sunday, December 6. You will be responsible for all purchases made under your name. Payment with cash, debit cards, personal checks, Visa and Mastercard are all accepted.

Once you have paid, you must pick up your item. All items purchased must be picked up in Salem unless other arrangements are made to have the item shipped. Shipping is available but buyer must cover all shipping costs.

If you purchase a firearm, transfer will take place in Salem. Winning bidder will also be responsible for any and all fees associated with the transfer of the firearm.
