Did you know?

A successful volunteer program can make an organization stronger and more effective.

Leveraging skills of volunteers can make your organization more adaptable and sustainable.

Retaining key volunteers allows your staff to spend more time furthering your mission and less time recruiting.

Only 19% of organizations have a staff person who has been trained to work with volunteers.

Why does it matter?

1/3 of volunteers quit after an initial volunteer session, reporting they had an unpleasant experience.

An additional 1/3 report dissatisfaction and shop around for an organization that fits.

An unknown number of volunteers talk about their experiences - good or not so good. They're talking to current or potential volunteers and current or potential supporters.

Having staff trained in Volunteer Engagement can make a critical difference for your organization in mission achievement, sustainability and even your bottom line.
