Barry is the CEO of the California Municipal Utilities Association, where he has worked since 2017. He leads an industry with \$8 billion in annual revenue.

For more than three decades, Barry has worked to improve communication and collaboration among people, whether as a volunteer with the United States Peace Corps in Guatemala or as a leader of associations, businesses, and government agencies. Barry has worked with the United States Department of Energy on natural gas and oil research, as well as energy efficiency and renewable energy. Barry and his wife also served in the United States Peace Corps in Guatemala, where he worked to conserve firewood and other natural resources. He was instrumental in helping several small villages build latrines where there were none.

Barry has extensive experience in the electricity sector, having worked on nearly every subject and resource, from power supply to customer service to safety. He was elected to the Board of Directors of the American Public Power Association.

In addition to his energy-related job, Mr. Moline spent two years as a high school teacher in the Chicago and St. Louis areas. Early in his career, he was a minor league hockey referee and refereed National Hockey League (NHL) games for numerous seasons. With more than 25 years of experience as a CEO, Barry has gained a great deal of knowledge about leadership and management. He and his staff collaborate with publicly owned water agencies and electric utilities to ensure that 40 million Californians have access to clean water and electricity.
