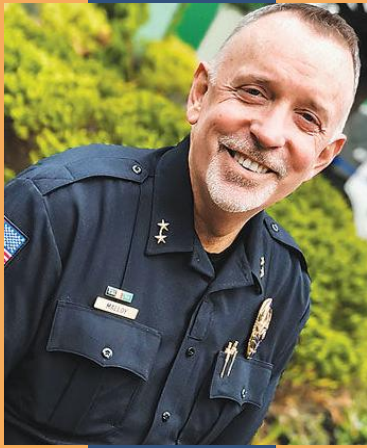




Jason Malloy

Chief of Police | Newport Police Department

Chief Jason Malloy has dedicated 35 years to the law enforcement profession, including 31 years with the Newport Police Department in Newport, Oregon. He was appointed Chief of Police in October 2016 after serving the department as a Patrol Officer, Sergeant, and Lieutenant. Prior to joining the Newport Police Department, Chief Malloy began his full-time law enforcement career with the Waldport Police Department. Throughout his career, he has served with three law enforcement agencies in Lincoln County, Oregon, spanning more than three decades of public service.

Chief Malloy holds a Bachelor of Science degree from Liberty University and is a graduate of the FBI National Academy and the Oregon Executive Development Institute. He has earned Police Executive Certification from the State of Oregon.

In addition to his law enforcement responsibilities, Chief Malloy is actively engaged in civic and community service. He serves on the Board of Directors representing the Lincoln County School District and is an active participant in the Newport Chamber of Commerce. A strong supporter of youth and community programs, he is a past President of Newport Boosters and has volunteered extensively as a youth sports coach, high school varsity baseball coach, and high school basketball official.
