The City of Gervais, OR is looking for a working Police Chief. The individual must have supervisory skills to oversee a department made up of one (1) Police Sergeant, two (2) Police Officers and an administrative assistant/evidence technician. The Chief reports to the City Manager.

Responsibilities include developing and maintaining the organization and the budget. Qualifications include communication skills to work with citizens, other law enforcement groups, crime victims and other community groups including the School District; skills in researching case law, reviewing, writing and developing enforcement procedures and policies to insure compliance with City, State and Federal laws and standards; knowledge of law enforcement activities, police practices and procedures; and skills to use law enforcement equipment, personal computers and standard office equipment.

The individual shall possess a valid Oregon driver's license and BPSST Advanced Certificate or equivalent. Must obtain a BPSST Supervisory Certificate within one year of hire. A BPSST Executive Certificate or equivalent is desirable. Salary range for starting in this position will be \$6,823-\$9,100 DOQ.
